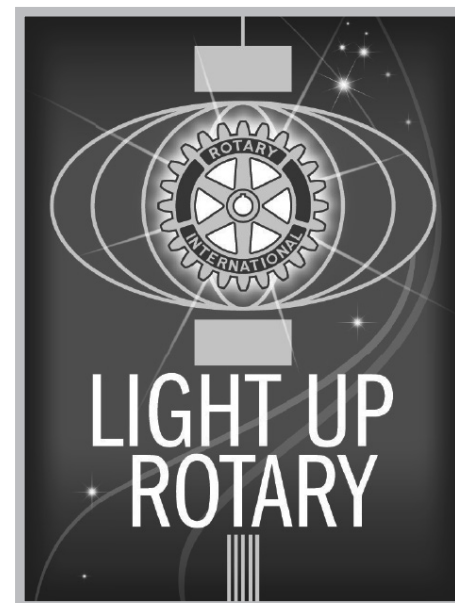

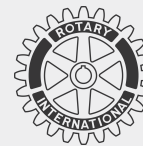
Community College
