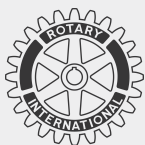

He was a Board Member for the United States conference of Mayors and Board Member for the Omaha Metropolitan Entertainment and Convention Authority (MECA).



In November 2012, he was elected to the University of Nebraska Board of Regents, where he currently serves.
