SkillsUSA is a national organization designed to improve the quality of America's workforce through a structured program of citizenship, leadership, employability, technical and professional skills training, information off the SkillsUSA website says.

The spokesman for the group is Hunter Gustafson. Hunter is a 2016 graduate of Fremont High School who worked on farms, excelled in the classroom and in the welding lab. At Fremont High School, Hunter participated in football, track, JV choir and SkillsUSA in which he was the president 2015-2016. Hunter also was involved in trapshooting and martial arts classes. A strong focused student, Hunter excelled in the classroom and in the Welding Academy classes during the 2014-15 school year. His welding skills helped him find employment with Mitch Sawyer his junior year, welding, fabricating and helping with general shop work. This year, Hunter continued his work with Sawyer by becoming the welding and fabrication supervisor. Hunter also excelled in SkillsUSA competition with his team: in 2015 State Champion welding/fabrication, later placing 11/32 at Nations, in 2016 again State Champion welding/fabrication, placing at Nations. The team, comprised of Hunter Gustafson, Kyeler TenEyck and Morgan Mayer finished fourth out of 36 welding teams in a competition to construct a jobsite toolbox.

Students on the welding fabrication team spent six weeks practicing the construction of the 4-foot x 3-foot x 2.5-foot steel toolbox before finally putting all their practice to the test at the National Conference. Their sponsors are Keith Cummings and Brad Ryun.

This October, Hunter plans to attend Southeast Community College.
