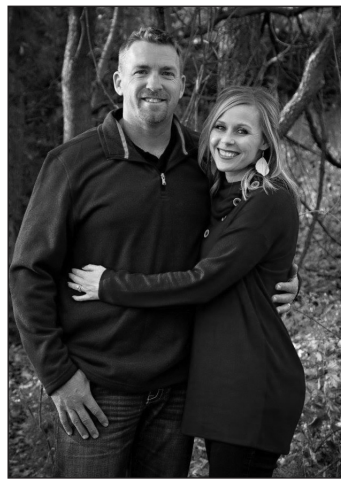

Clubs reap benefits from flexibility options

The Council on Legislation gave Rotary clubs more freedom on meetings and membership. Clubs that have taken advantage of the flexibility have reported increased membership, greater diversity, and more engaged members. Here are some of the ways.

Flexible Meetings – The Rotary Club of Singapore East replaced two of its monthly meetings with less formal gatherings focusing on service projects and fellowship.

Reduced Dues – The Rotary Club of Capitol Hill, Washington, D.C., doubled membership in six months by adopting changes, including adding two membership categories: one for young professionals at half the regular dues, and one for spouses or partners at one-third the cost.

Corporate Membership – Corporate memberships give busy executives the chance to get involved without committing to regular weekly meetings. The Rotary Club of Melbourne, Victoria, Australia, has 17 corporate members form six businesses who take turns attending meetings.

Shared Membership – At the Rotary Club in Deerfield, Ill., up to five people can share a membership, taking turns attending meetings.
