

Lee Meyer serves as the Executive Director of the Fremont Opera House and directs community plays there. She has been a music and theatre teacher in Nebraska schools from classes A to D. She retired from Fremont High School and is now an adjunct professor in music and theatre at Midland University where she continues to direct and be involved in theatre productions. Through her career as an educator and director, Meyer was named Thespian Director of the Year,



NCAA Volunteer of the Year and Fremont Rotary Teacher of the Year.



Cindi Lamprecht represents the Fremont Opera House as Treasurer of the Board of Directors. She is a retired music teacher from Fremont High School and currently directs the Adult Choir, Bell Choir, and the Children's Choir at Sinai Lutheran Church. Cindi has served on many community boards, most recently as President of Rebuilding Together. Cindi's husband, Lynn, is a member of the Fremont Rotary.

The Fremont Opera House

The Fremont Opera House, formerly the Love Opera House, held its grand opening performance on the evening of December 14, 1888. This was the start to nearly 28 years of successful live theater.

The five-story structure was considered one of the finest buildings in the state, with a seating capacity of 1,100. The theater space, located on the upper three floors, was ornate with an impressive domed ceiling. The facility served the community well for many years, yet sadly the upper floors of this historic structure have been closed to the public for decades.

In 1975, the Opera House became the first building in Fremont to join the National Registry of Historic Places. It earned this recognition due to its fine architecture and physical size.

This building also added to its history by surviving the Pathfinder Hotel explosion in 1976. Even though there was damage to the façade, amazingly the building remained structurally sound. Of the more than 500 opera houses built in Nebraska, only a handful remain.
