

STEM Club

Brett Meyer is a University of Nebraska graduate holding degrees from the University of Nebraska Kearney and the University of Nebraska at Omaha.

In the summer of 2017 Brett joined the staff at Trinity Lutheran School working as its coordinator of STEM education. In this role he collaborates with preschool to 8th grade teachers bringing high quality, world-driven STEM education to the classroom. He also is the lead teacher for the Trinity/Bergan after-



school STEM and oversees the Pinnacle Bank aquaponics system. Fun fact: in April of 2020 the Fremont Area United Way contacted Brett asking for assistance with the development of personal protective equipment for frontline workers serving under the umbrella of the Three Rivers Health Department. With the assistance of current and former students, including STEM Club students from Archbishop Bergan, Trinity was able to print over 250 face shields.

STEM education at Trinity would not be possible without the generosity of area businesses, such as Pinnacle Bank, the Rupert Dunklau Foundation, Jon Gilfry of Wealth Partners, the Fremont Area Community Foundation and donations from individuals and businesses dedicated to growing STEM education throughout the Fremont community.
